GOALS

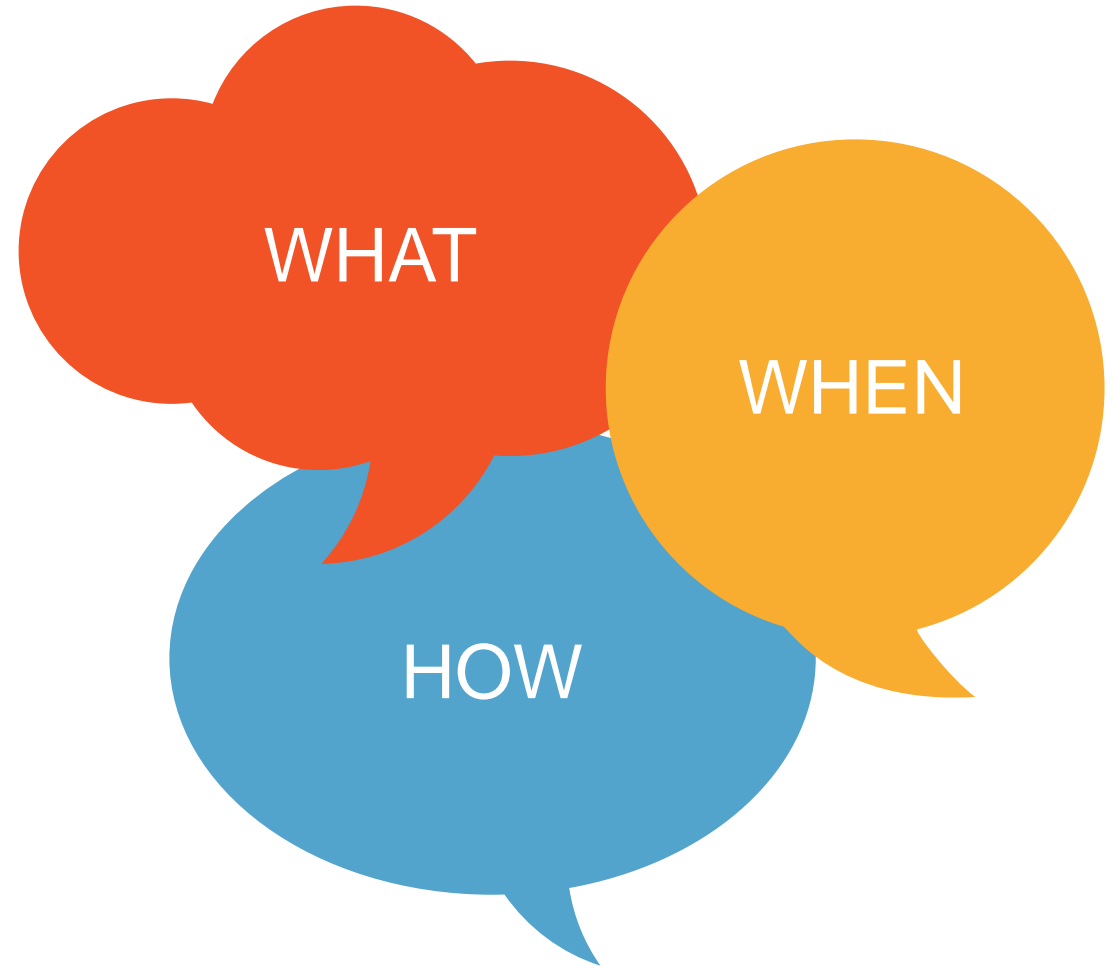
to supply the medicines and medical services that benefit patients and the health system

The community consultation:



- Aims to gather a wide variety of views and perspectives
- Will be used to form priority actions to support consumers' perspectives being included in HTA processes

How are consumer views collected during HTA now?



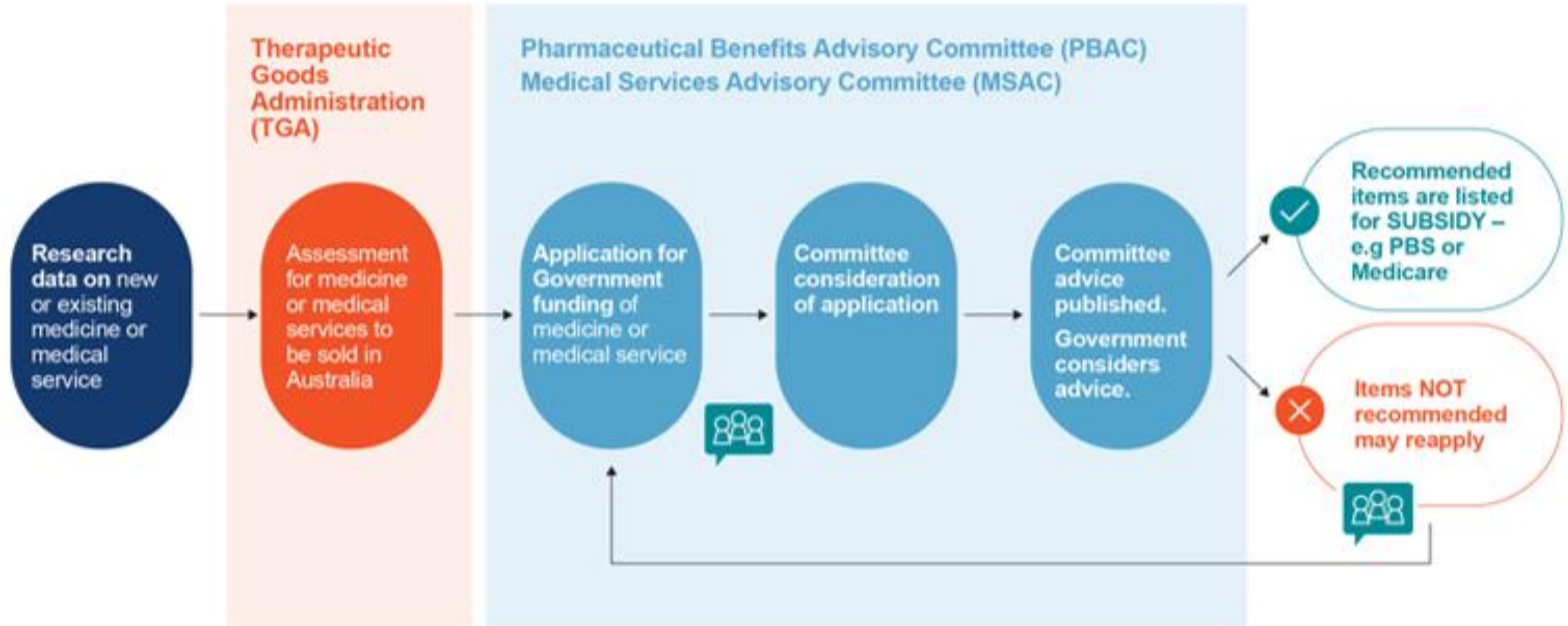
Consumers are asked to answer a survey which collects their views and experiences on a particular medicine or medical service.

This information is then provided to the Health Technology Assessment (HTA) committee advising the government on whether to fund the health technology.

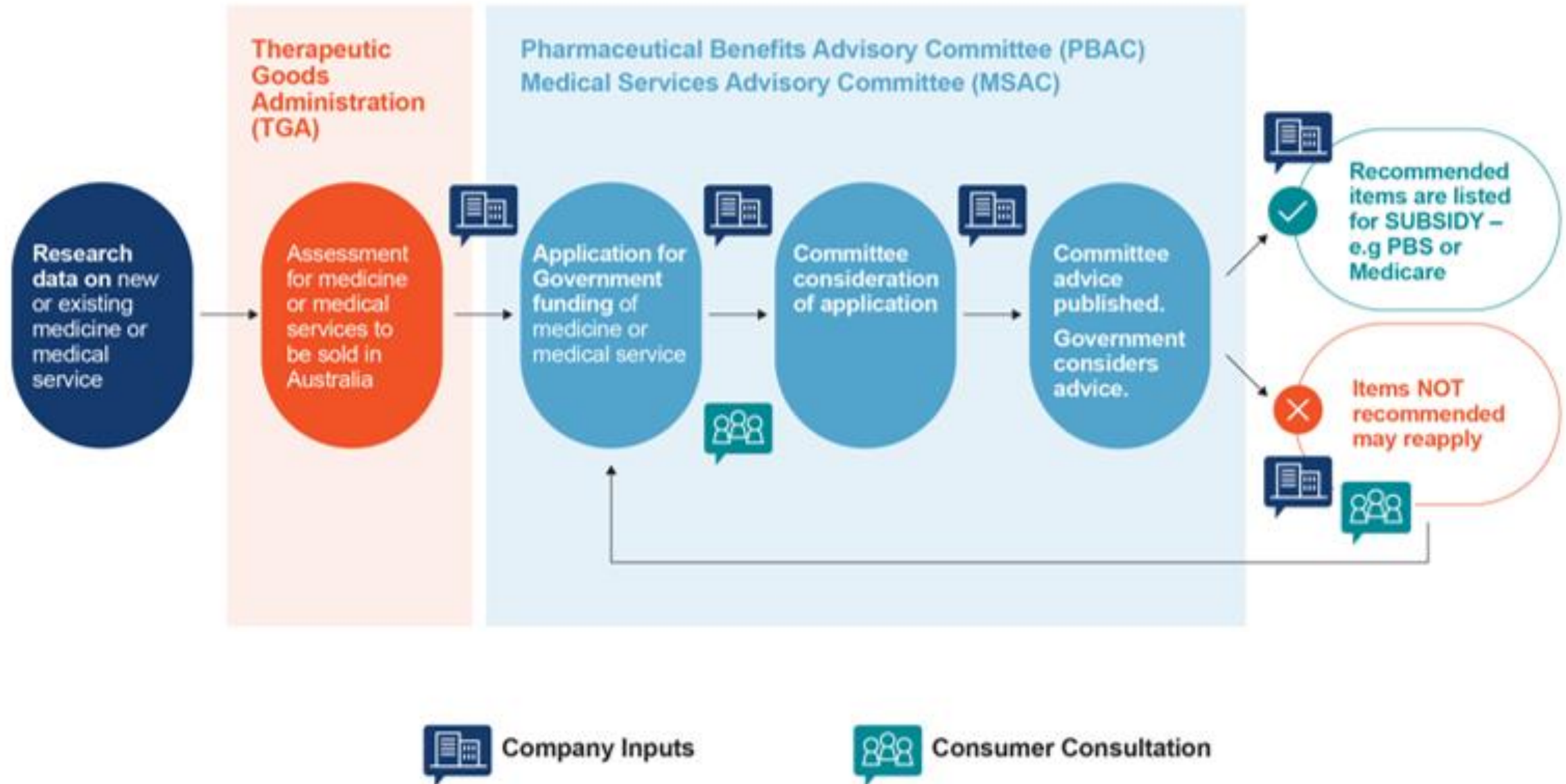
